What is Careers of Tomorrow Expo?

In previous years, MontcoWorks hosted the youth event known as ManuFest and More which primarily focused on careers in manufacturing and trades. This year, we have rebranded and expanded the event, now known as **Careers of Tomorrow Expo** which will include more industries such as healthcare, IT, education, public safety and more.

The event is more “career-awareness” focused and set up specifically for 8th – 12th graders. It is an excellent opportunity for students, parents, and educators to connect with local and regional employers, experience activities, see product demonstrations, and learn about different career paths in various Industries.

Who should attend?

Where/when is Careers of Tomorrow Expo?

The event will be held at **The Greater Philadelphia Expo Center in Oaks, PA on Tuesday, September 27, 2022 from 9:00am to 1:00pm in Hall B.**

Do I have to register ahead of time?
